



## **2018 ProMotion Plus Leadership Award Framework**

To identify, recognize and celebrate the accomplishment(s) of an individual, organization, or group in Kamloops community and area that has challenged the traditional limits for women and girls in physical activity and/or sport and in doing so has supported girls and women to participate more fully as participants, competitors and/or leaders.

### Award Criteria

- ♦ The Leadership Awards are presented to:
  - \* a recipient (male or female) that has increased participation enhanced or improved access and opportunities for girls/women in Kamloops OR
  - \* an individual female or group of females to recognize their personal achievements in sport, recreation or physical activity.
- ♦ Nominations may include but are not limited to the achievements of athletes, teams, coaches, officials, administrators, or volunteers and programs or special events, which increased or enhanced opportunities for girls and women.
- ♦ The focus should emphasize the candidate's achievements of past 2 years (2016-18).

For example this award could recognize:

- a new, enhanced or expanded program or service.
- the achievements of an athlete, coach or official in their school, region or the province.
- competitive achievements of an athlete, coach or official at a province-wide or broader competition/event.
- a special event that was targeted toward the participation of girls and women under the age of 19.
- an organization for putting on a special event for women and girls under the age of 19.

### Nomination Process

Nominators will need to submit the nomination form via email to [sport@bcwintergames.ca](mailto:sport@bcwintergames.ca) or in person to the Sports Council Office at 262 Lorne Street.

The nomination form should include:

- Candidate's name, contact info and community role.
- Nominator's name and contact information.

- A brief statement (no more than one page) describing why they have chosen to nominate their candidate with specifics on their accomplishments in the promotion of girls and/or women in sport, physical activity or recreation.
- Include any awards, certificates, commendation, citations or other accomplishments specific to the Award Criteria.

**Deadline for nominations is Friday December 1<sup>st</sup>, 2017**

Selection Process

Once all the nominations have been submitted, the Sport Directorate Team will choose three candidates who best showcase the leadership award criteria. The three finalists will be presented to the BC Games Society Board of Directors in January who will choose the winner. The recipient will be notified and invited to the Civic Luncheon on Friday February 23<sup>rd</sup> where they will be honoured with the award.
